Reserve Bank of India has advised Banks to withdraw non-CTS 2010 standards cheques in circulation before December 31, 2012 and implement 'Standardisation and Enhancement of Security Features in Cheque Forms'.

As per the directives issued by Reserve Bank of India (RBI), for Standardisation and Enhancement of Security Features in Cheque Forms – Migrating to CTS 2010 standards, all branches of Bank have to issue only CTS-2010 Standard Cheques to customers.

In this regard, we wish to inform that the CTS-2010 standard Cheque book issued to the customers will have cheque leaves printed with words 'CTS 2010' on each of the cheque leaf.

RBI vide its circular dated September 3, 2012 has now advised Banks to withdraw non-CTS 2010 standards cheques in circulation before December 31,2012.

Accordingly, we request our customers to surrender existing non CTS- 2010 cheque book at any of our branches on or before December 31, 2012 and place a request of issuance of new cheque book with CTS-2010 standards.

Please also ensure to replace the post dated non-CTS 2010 standard cheques issued by you, which are due after December 31, 2012 with CTS 2010 standard cheques.
